

NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS, AND ADDITION OF DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION TO RULEMAKING FILE

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the California Office of the Small Business Advocate (CalOSBA) within the California Business and Economic Development (GO-Biz) is providing notice of changes made to proposed regulations originally noticed to the public in the California Regulatory Notice Register on April 25, 2025. These changes include the incorporation by reference of the "Brand Guidelines 2026".

Additionally, pursuant to the requirements of Government Code sections 11346.8(d), 11346.9(a)(1), and 11347.1, GO-Biz/CalOSBA is providing notice that documents and other information which the agency has relied upon in adopting the proposed regulations have been added to the rulemaking file and are available for public inspection and comment.
